

The **SPARTAN HALL OF FAME** recognizes students, teams or staff members, who while at MHS brought honor to MHS through their athletic abilities or talents in the visual and performing arts.

General Criteria

- Alumni may be nominated at least five years after graduating, and must have demonstrated good citizenship as a student and as a graduate
- Current or retired MHS staff may be nominated after at least 10 years of service

Athletic Criteria

- Named to a high school All-American team
- Individual or team state championship
- National tournament championship
- Selected to the Patriot-News all-league, all-district, all-area, or all-state team

Visual and Performing Arts Criteria

- Selection to perform or have work performed or exhibited regionally, statewide, nationally or internationally
- Recognition from a state, national or international arts adjudication group
- Recognition from a government official or agency for contributions to the arts or arts education
- Recognition as a significant contributor to the development /growth of the arts

Nomination requirements

- Name, phone number and e-mail address of the person making the nomination
- Name of the graduate being nominated, class year, address, and nomination category
- Statement describing why the person qualifies for the award
- Letters of support, certificates of achievement, and newspaper/magazine articles are appreciated

Deadline: December 31 to be considered for recognition at Homecoming the following year. Nominations, however, are accepted throughout the year and are filed for future consideration.

The **ALUMNUS OF THE YEAR AWARD** is the most prestigious of the three awards. Each year, MHS honors one graduate who demonstrates the following:

- Humanitarianism and exemplary service to others
- High standards of integrity through his or her personal life
- Outstanding achievement in his or her career field

Nomination requirements

- Name, phone number and e-mail address of the person making the nomination
- Name of the graduate being nominated, class year and address
- Nominating statement that outlines how the graduate being nominated has met all of the criteria listed above. The statement should be no longer than three typewritten, single-spaced, 8½ x 11-inch pages
- Letters of support, newspaper/magazine articles and resumes/curriculum vitae are appreciated, and may be submitted in addition to the nominating statement

Deadline: October 1 to be considered for recognition in June of the following year. Nominations, however, are accepted throughout the year and are kept on file for future consideration.

Alumni Achievement Award

The **ALUMNI ACHIEVEMENT AWARD** honors alumni who have demonstrated outstanding achievements in one of the following areas:

Career Achievement

- Has performed unique or significant accomplishments in his/her business or professional career

Academic Excellence

- While pursuing a degree, held leadership positions or was actively involved in the campus community while maintaining a GPA of 3.0 or higher
- While pursuing a degree, achieved a level of excellence or GPA to earn summa cum laude, magna cum laude or cum laude

Community service

- Distinguished involvement in community service/volunteering
- Has been recognized for community service involvement

Nomination requirements

- Name, phone number and e-mail address of the person making the nomination
- Name of the graduate being nominated, class year, address, and category for which he/she is being nominated
- Nominating statement that describes why you believe the person qualifies for the award; provide as much information as possible
- Letters of support, certificates of achievement, newspaper/magazine articles, and resumes/curriculum vitae are appreciated

Deadline: October 1 to be considered for recognition in April of the following year. Nominations, however, are accepted throughout the year and are kept on file for future consideration.
